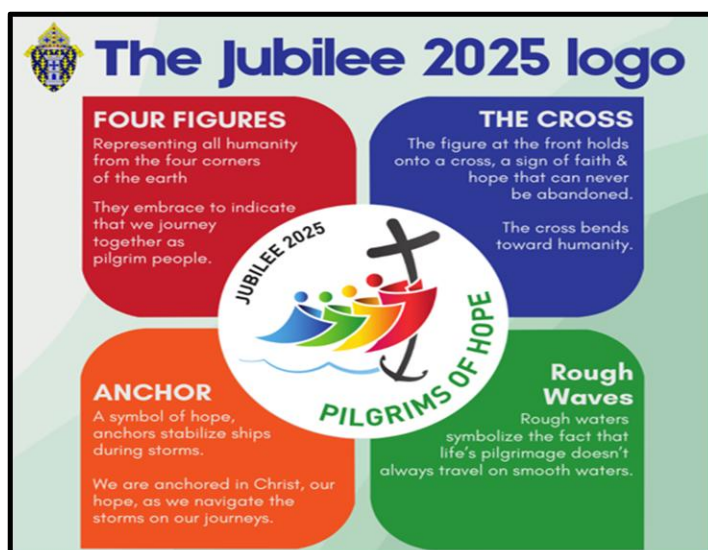

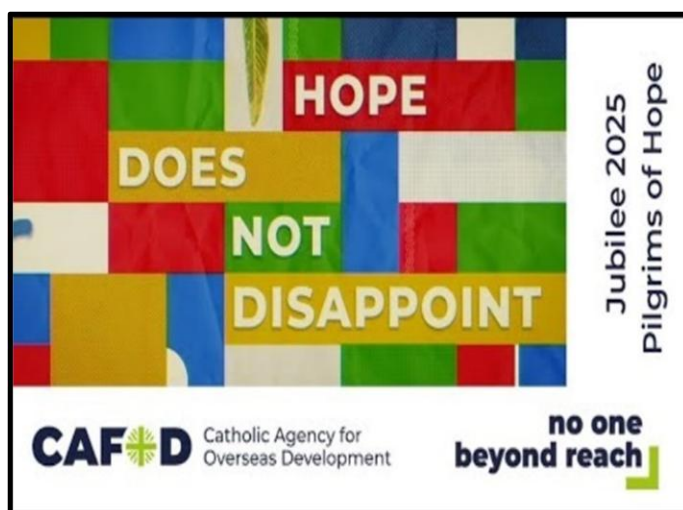
Flame

St Patrick's Day

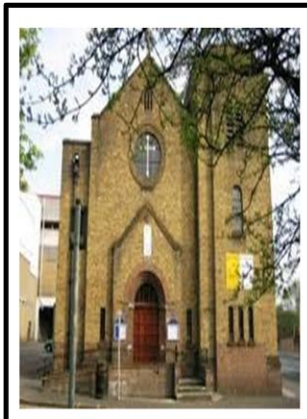
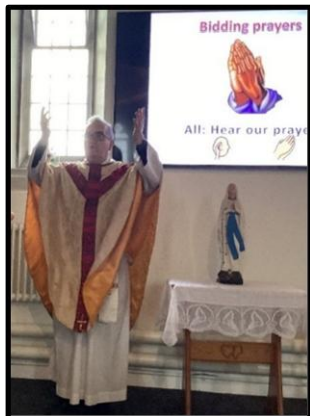
Robert Shaw / 3P Class Team led a special assembly to share information about St Patrick and all things associated with the culture and traditions of Ireland.
