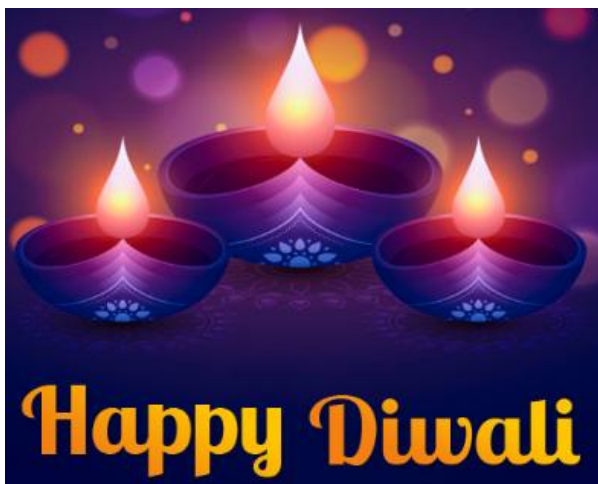
September Mass

In September, we had our first Mass of the school year which was prepared by Sundus Zaidan PH+D. The theme was to celebrate The Birthday of Our Lady.



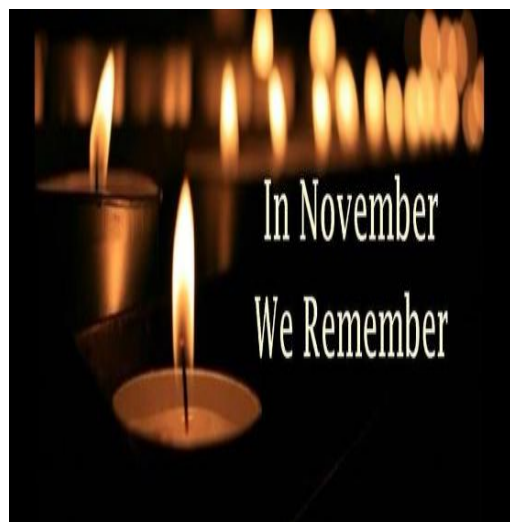
Deanery Mass

We had a special Assembly for Remembrance Day. As well as remembering those who gave their lives during the war we also prayed for our own family and friends in our Community.

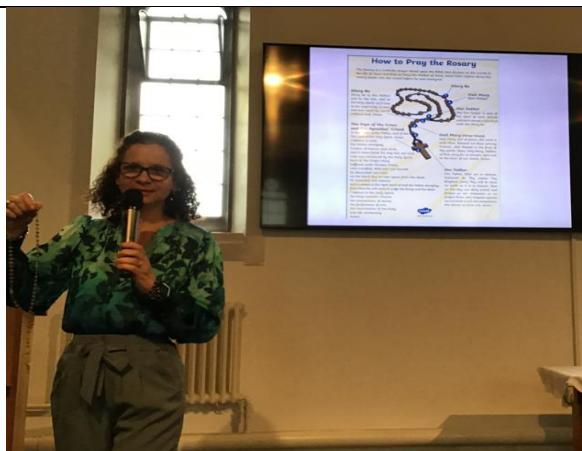
As part of our In November – We Remember activities, we had a display in Reception and there was a chance for people to contribute to The National Poppy Appeal.
