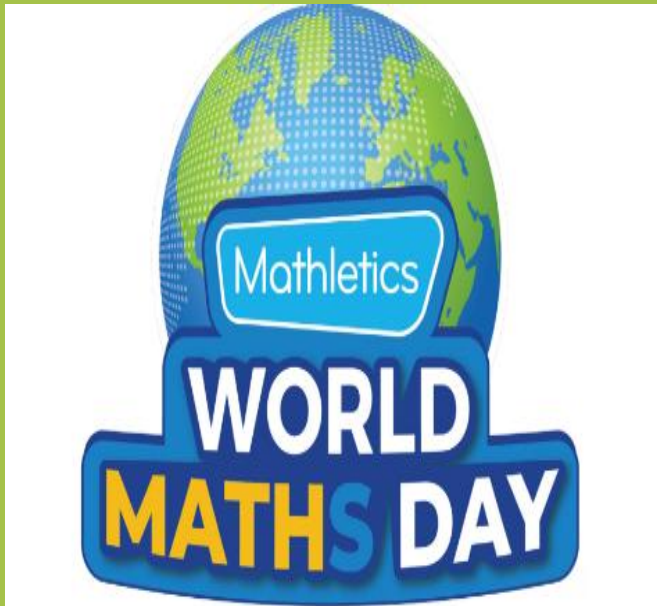
# Mother's Day

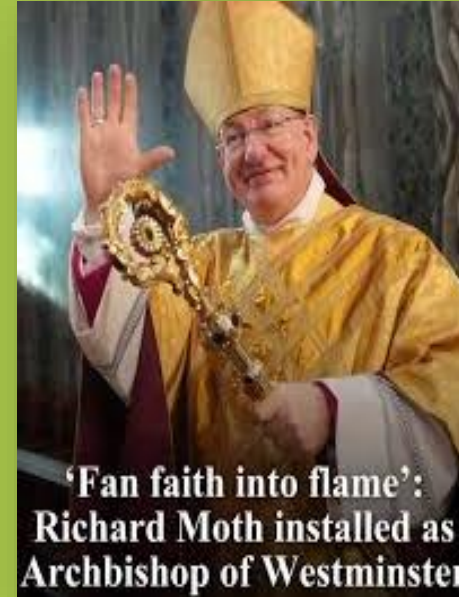
# Number Day

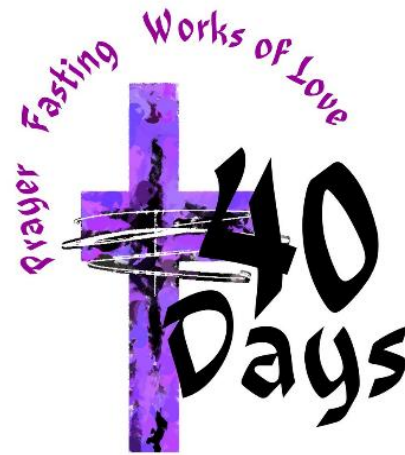
# Archbishop Richard Moth
