Chromatography



- 1. Cut 3 strips from your coffee filter.
- 2. Tape the strips to the pencils, one for each.
- 3. Draw a line with the markers onto the strips (a thick line across an inch above the bottom). Make sure each paper strip has only one colour on them!
- 4. Fill your glasses with water so that it will touch the bottom of the paper only.
- 5. Hang your papers in the glasses and wait for the colours to separate!

You will need:

- 1. Water
- 2. 3 clear glasses
- 3.1 coffee filter
- 4. 3 pencils
- 5. Tape
- 6. Markers (3 colours)
- 7. Scissors

The science behind:

Chromatography is a way of separating out a mixture of chemicals, which are in gas or liquid form, by letting them creep slowly past another substance, which is typically a liquid or solid.

So in our case we had the ink (liquid) dissolved in water creeping over the surface of the paper (solid).
